## FAQ- SPECIAL EVENT & OFFICE VOLUNTEERS

---

### How do I help with special events?

Special event volunteers help in a wide range of ways. From pre-planning to assisting at events, these volunteers will be at planning meeting, setting up, manning tables and booths, tearing down, and providing assistance throughout the event.

### How much time should I expect to have to donate as a special event volunteer?

The amount of time depends on the level of involvement the volunteer would like to have with the event and the nature of the event. The minimum is usually four hours on a single day working at an event- ex. Manning a table at the Eastland Old Rip Festival or selling tickets at the Boots and Bags Bingo Event.

### Do I have to work every event the ECCC does?

No. As a special event volunteer, you would pick and choose which event you would like to be a part of and how you would like to help.

### If I'm not working with clients, why do I have to have a background check?

Grants and ECCC policies require all volunteers representing the agency and having access to the public successfully pass the criminal, DFPS, and sex offender registry checks.

### What does an office volunteer do?

Office volunteers provide assistance with filing, shredding, assisting with entering in client data, and helping out with sorting donations received.

### How much time should I expect to have to donate as an office volunteer?

Office volunteers set their own schedules on a weekly, monthly, or as needed basis. Hours are normal business hours- Monday-Friday from 8am-5pm.
