## Join our Team as a Volunteer

The Eastland County Crisis Center provides many different victim and community services in regards to the recognition, response, and prevention of domestic violence, sexual assault, and child abuse. This work is made possible in large part to the work of Special Events and Victim Advocate Volunteers who donate approximately 4,000 hours a year to the ECCC.

Special Event Volunteers invest their time and expertise to help create and host various community outreach and fundraising events in Eastland County. These volunteers attend an Orientation class prior to serving and then choose the events they would like to be a part of.

Victim Advocate Volunteers complete training over the various components of victim advocacy and then choose the days they have available to serve alongside other volunteers and staff on after hours crisis intake calls.
